SMC is designed to identify, challenge, and reward talented students in mathematics. The contest also serves as the selection process for students who will represent Nigeria at the European Girls Mathematics Olympiad (EGMO)

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to participate in the Special Maths Contest, a participant must:

- Be between 12 and 18 years old
- **Not** be enrolled in a university or higher education system.

All participants must meet the above conditions to compete. **Proof of** eligibility may be required, and SMC reserves the right to disqualify any participant who fails to meet these requirements.

FORMAT OF THE CONTEST

The SMC shall consist of 2 rounds:

Round 1 (Online Test)

- Date: Saturday, 17th January, 2026.
- Format: 25 multiple-choice questions.
- Time limit: 2 hours.
- Subjects covered: Algebra, Number Theory, Geometry, and Combinatorics.
- The contest will be conducted on a **proctored online platform** to ensure fairness and credibility.
- The exam will start at 14:00 on Saturday, 17th January, 2026.
- **Results announcement**: January 30, 2026.

2. Round 2 (In-Person Competition)

- 30-70 students will be shortlisted for the second round based on their performance in Round 1.
- These shortlisted candidates will fall under the following categories:

- Nigerian contestants: Physical or Online participation based on their score in the first round.
- International students: Those not based in Nigeria will participate virtually via Zoom.
- **Event duration**: 27th February 3rd March, 2026
- **Location**: Nile university of Nigeria, Abuja.
- Format: Contestants will solve four Olympiad-style essay problems.
- SMC reserves the right to upgrade Nigerian participants from online to physical attendance for Round 2 if necessary.

TIE-BREAKER RULE

In the event that two or more contestants achieve the same score in Round 2, their Round 1 scores will be used as the tiebreaker to determine ranking and award positions.

PRIZES
